

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION: The main goal

- That the participants deepen their knowledge and understanding of learning and teaching in a multicultural society and develop their ability to lead school work on that basis.
- That the participants learn to have human dignity, democracy and social justice as their guiding light in their work.



What is this study about?

- That students receive specialization in responding to the diverse needs of students, whether it is their academic, social, or emotional needs or support for learning Icelandic
- That children and young people with different prerequisites for learning are provided with conditions to develop and learn in community with others.



Organisation of studies

Three main programmes:

- Inclusive education and special needs
- Inclusive education and support services
- Inclusive education a diploma study



Inclusive education and special education

- Admission requires applicants to have completed a B.Ed. with 90 credits for specialisation in the field of preschool or compulsory school education, or in a subject of compulsory education.
- The focus is on students acquire competence in working with others in developing a school culture where everyone can enjoy their strengths.
- The programme is 120ECTS ending with MEd
- Choice between two specialisations:
 - Diversity among children and young people
 - Multilingualism and multiculturalism



Inclusive education and support services

- The programme is intended for teachers with a license and teaching experience.
- The goal of the program is for participants to strengthen their professionalism for learning and teaching in an inclusive school in a multicultural society, as well as their ability to lead school work on that basis.
- The programme is 120ECTS ending with MEd







Inclusive education – diploma study

- The programme is primarily aimed at those who want to add to their knowledge in the field of inclusive education
- Admission requires two years of work experience in support services in a preschool or compulsory school.
- The focus is mainly on how to prepare children and young people with different prerequisites for learning, and provide them with conditions for developing and learning in community with others.
- The programme is 60 ECTS
